

1. Connect the power adapter to the power port on the Pulse device.
 - All of the lights in the Pulse device will flash briefly.
 - If you do not see a blue light flashing on the back of the Pulse, press and hold the button on the back of Pulse until you see the blue light flashing.
2. On the ntouch VP2, go to Settings, Device Options, Bluetooth, and select **Scan for devices**. (You may need to check “**Allow Bluetooth devices?**”)
3. After a few seconds, the ntouch VP2 will detect the Pulse device.
4. Select the **Pair** button under **Available Bluetooth devices** where the SVRS Pulse shows up to connect the Pulse to the ntouch VP2.
5. If the Pulse device is able to successfully pair to the ntouch VP2, you will then see the name of the Pulse device (for example, SVRS Pulse) under “**Saved/Paired Bluetooth devices**” with the checkmark to the right side of the device name.
 - If the checkmark is not there, give it a few minutes as it may be downloading an update. If it does not show up within 10 minutes, then unplug and plug in the Pulse device.
