Care doesn't end when the appointment does. Reliable communication access is the foundation of patient-centered audiology.

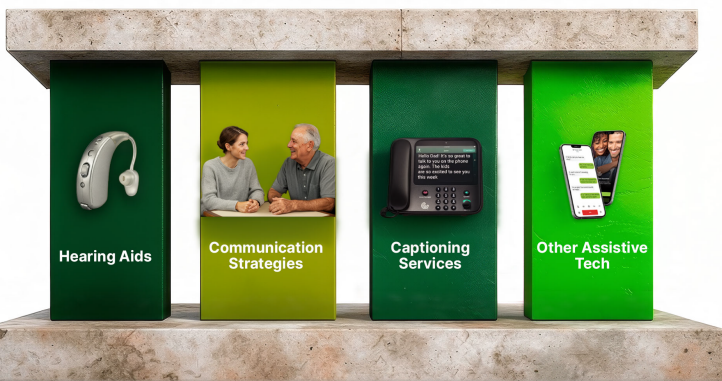
The ability to communicate is essential to independence. Quality care must address real-world communication environments (like phone calls), not just clinical settings.
